estled at the south end of Mahe in Baie Lazare, the white sandy beaches here were made for couples to intertwine their footsteps in the sand.

Rooms and suites all feature spectacular views of the coastline and verdant greenery. This hotel was made for couples who don't like to sit still for too long with activities ranging from hill trekking to scuba diving, surfing, tennis,

yoga and cultural dance lessons.
